A +1.5 spread is commonly seen in baseball betting, the standard runline for MLB. This split means the underdog must win outright or lose by exactly one run.

Alternative: a parlay 1.5 spread means that an underdog must win by at least two runs. Many baseball gamblers have decided on fewer (than two runs).

What is a runline? In sports betting, a runline is a spread of runs that a team must win or lose by. For example, a -1.5 runline means a team must win by at least two runs. A +1.5 runline means a team must win outright or lose by one run.

On how many days is a runline bet? A runline bet is typically placed on the day of the game. However, some sportsbooks offer runline bets on games that are scheduled for a later date.

You can bet on a runline in several ways. You can bet on a team to win by a certain number of runs, or you can bet on a team to lose by a certain number of runs. You can also bet on a runline as part of a parlay bet.
