The underlying algorithm for the Plinko simulator is based on a two-dimensional array with the width and height of the board being simulated. The values in the array correspond with slots between a row of pegs, an empty position is represented by a zero, and the current position of the chip is represented by a one. So, You Want to Win (40 ft) and, similar to a pachinko game or bean machine; it also is similar to the board used in the Plinko pricing game on The Price Is Right. The bottom of the Board is divided into 15 slots marked with various U.S. dollar amounts, alternately with high and low values.
