The PAID version will serve you well at all stake levels - the difference in the two versions is substantial, but frankly the vast majority of players [over 97%?] haven't got the work ethic + analytical mindset needed to truly benefit from any of the analysis tools out there. The same is true for poker tracker s/ware & HUD users - something like 90% or more of users are clueless about the reports & opponents analysis potential of the trackers - they half understand the table HUD stats that's all. This is good news for me as the under use & misuse of HM2/PT4 has created a vast army of exploitable, multi-tabling nitty regs - they are in fact the fish these days & have been so for a few years as they grind out their bonus whoring 2 bb/100 miserable lives. There's two free versions of, one for Hold'em & the other for Omaha.
