a in Curitiba, while the second leg &#128200; was hosted by Palmeiras on 2 Marc

&lt;p&gt;Palmeiras defeated Athletico Paranaense 4 2 on aggregate &#128200; to

ged basis, with the Copa Libertadores champions hosting the second leg. If tied  
on aggregate, the away goals rule would &#128200; not be used, and 30 minutes o  
f extra time would be played. If still tied after extra time, the penalty &#1282  
00; shoot-out would be used to determine the winners (Regulations Article 17).[

alty into stoppage time during the first leg, was excluded of the &#128200; tea
