The registration process at bwin is somewhat different from other websites, with eight small steps that can be completed very quickly. In fact, the whole process took us only about three minutes. Below is a brief breakdown of each section.

As soon as you open bwin's website, you will be redirected to the home page. Click on the yellow-coloured REGISTER button at the top-right hand side of your screen. You will then be redirected to the registration form, as can be seen from the image below.

The country of residence is automatically set to the UK, though you can change this should you need to. Afterwards, enter your email address and hit Continue when you're done.

The second step of bwin's registration process requires you to create a unique password. As shown in the image above, you must include a number of special characters. Once you're satisfied, hit NEXT.

Very simple. Just add your full name and be sure to select whichever prefix you identify yourself with.

Add your date of birth. Of course, you must be over 18 to register with any UK bookie.

Add your phone number.

Fill in your current address. This process is made even more efficient with an automatic search bar, meaning that adding your postal code will be enough to get the search going.

The penultimate step is an optional one. bwin, like many other websites, sends promotions to its customers. It's up to you to decide where you want to receive the information, or if you want to receive it at all.

The final step. GBP (the pound) is already automatically included, though you can simply select your p
