A key difference between Blackjack and Spanish 21 is that, in Spanish 21, 10s are removed from the deck. In Spanish 21, a BlackJack occurs when the first two cards dealt are an Ace and a 10-value card (Jack, Queen, King, and A). This is because the probability of getting a blackjack (an Ace and a 10-value card) is higher in Spanish 21 than in standard Blackjack.

Spanish 21 has a higher RTP than standard Blackjack. In Spanish 21, the RTP is approximately 99.6%, while in standard Blackjack, it is approximately 99.5%. This is because the removal of 10s from the deck increases the probability of getting a blackjack, which is a winning hand.
