A key difference between Blackjack and Spanish 21 is that, all 10s are removed from the deck in Spanish 21. In Blackjack, the first two cards dealt are dealt equal; an combination of a face Card (Jack), Queen, King, and A. This is because the 10-value cards are removed, increasing the probability of getting a blackjack (an Ace and a 10-value Card). BT /F
