

gogo poker

On April 15, 2011, the U.S. Attorney's Office for The Southern District of New York sued and shut down PokerStars and several of its competitors' sites, alleging that the sites were violating federal rebranding fraud and money laundering laws. The lawsuit also alleges that the sites were using stolen credit card information to play poker.

While the lawsuit is ongoing, the U.S. Attorney's Office has issued a subpoena for the records of the sites. The sites have refused to comply with the subpoena, and the U.S. Attorney's Office has filed a motion for contempt of court.
