g required to reveal their hand. If more than one player remains 🛡 in c

ontention after the final betting round, a showdown takes place where the hands

are revealed, and the player with 🛡 the winning hand takes the pot.<

<p>With the exception of initial forced bets, money is only placed into th

e pot voluntarily 🛡 by a player who either believes the bet has a posit

ive expected value or who is trying to bluff other 🛡 players for variou

s strategic reasons. Thus, while the outcome of any particular hand significantl

y involves chance, the long-run expectations of 🛡 the players are deter

mined by their actions chosen on the basis of probability, psychology, and game
