Just because something is classic doesn't mean it can't look modern. 3D European Roulette, released by Iron Dog Studio in July 2024, is a good example of this: it has a graphic and effect quality that you can't even see in most roulette games today. Its interface contains many elements that will make gameplay easier, and you can also try your luck in basic racetrack bets. But perhaps the most important feature is that it uses the rules of La Partage: thanks to this, the RTP of the game can be higher than the classic European variant. 3D European Roulette doesn't have side bets, multipliers, or bonus games, but it offers the vanilla version of the game in the best possible way.

3D European Roulette Features

The RTP of 3D European Roulette is 97,30%, but if you only use the even money bets, which triggers the La Partage rules, the RTP goes up to 98,65%. The volatility is medium. The coin range of the game is 0.25 - 200. The minimum bet is 0.50, and the maximum table limit is set at 500.

The maximum amount you can win is 10.000. The game interface can be viewed in five different languages, and it is optimized for smartphones & tablets. The game looks pretty impressive and contains lots of transition effects, but it is still classic European roulette. By clicking the racetrack area on the interface, you can open the French bets section and try your chance on Tiers, Orphelins, and Voisins too. Another important thing you should know is the La Partage rule. This means if you place an even money bet (red/black, odd/even, Tj T* BT /F1 12 Tf 50 112 Td (& low/high) and 81; half of your wager is returned - this is what makes the RTP rate for even bets higher than usual.
