<p>Well, an easy answer is that you can just do it. Loading funds onto you

r PayPal account or transferring those funds to play online poker is very si

mple.</p>

<p>To begin with, you don't really have to load your PayPal account ahead

of time to make purchases.</p>

<p>Start by making your deposit from the cashier and choosing your method

of payment. Then, once the account is synced with PayPal, authorize the paym

ent through PayPal and finish the transaction in PokerStars (as an example)

or whatever client you're using that accepts this method.</p>

<p>Obviously be wary of deposit limits and make sure you've made a pur

chase on PayPal within 12 months or you may have more difficulty with withdrawal

s.</p>

<p>If you have any other depositing or withdrawal methods, those may a

lso be used prior to the PayPal account so keep that in mind.</p>
