Cristiano Ronaldo has been blasted by a former Sporting Lisbon manager for being "greedy", also claiming Manchester United star Bruno Fernandes took the right approach in confronting him. In a sensational rant from Manuel Jose, the Portuguese superstar has been accused of chasing money and adopting a selfish attitude, leading him to call for Ronaldo to be removed from the national team squad.

The 38-year-old took his tally for Portugal to 122 goals in 198 caps in braces in their Euro 2024 qualifier victories against Liechtenstein and Luxembourg, meaning he now holds both records of most caps won for their country and scoring the highest number of international goals in the men's game.

But Fernandes took on Ronaldo in public for praising the appointment of new coach Roberto Martinez after falling out with Fernando Santos at the World Cup, calling the Spaniard a "breath of fresh air". Fernandes disagreed with him about the Selecao coach's new methods, hinting at some tension underneath the surface from their time at Old Trafford.

"No, it's just a new coach, with new ideas," Fernandes said when asked about Martinez's impact. "There's no breath of fresh air at all. It's just a transitional period. The atmosphere in the national team has always been good."
